

Autumn Zodiac Camp

Everything needs to be packed INSIDE a single backpack that the Scout can transport by themselves, carrying between transport connections and on hikes of several miles to and from the camp.

Where two items of the same description are listed, the Scout may choose to wear one and only carry a single spare.

(Kit list created by Expedition team themselves and ratified by Volunteer Leadership team)

NOTE:

Due to site safety rules NO BALL GAMES IOR THROWING ACTIVITY permitted on the camp area.

Due to current fire prevention warnings NO OPEN FIRES permitted on the camp area.

Activities

- ☐ Walking boots
- ☐ 2x walking socks (pair)

Catering

- ☐ Knife, fork & spoon
- ☐ Packed lunch
- ☐ Plate, bowl & mug
Unbreakable items are best (e.g. metal).
- ☐ Tea-towel
- ☐ Water bottle
At least 750ml.

Clothing

- ☐ 2x Fleece / top
NOTE: Cotton garments such as hoodies and sweatshirts don't dry particularly quickly and are cold when damp; most fleece remains warm even when damp and dries quicker
- ☐ Flip-flops / crocs
- ☐ Gloves
- ☐ Shorts
- ☐ 2x Socks (pair)
- ☐ Sun hat
- ☐ t-shirt / polo
- ☐ 2x thermal / base layer
- ☐ 2x Trousers
Quick drying (not jeans/tracksuits).
- ☐ 2x Underwear
- ☐ Uniform (Neckerchief only)
- ☐ Warm hat
- ☐ Waterproof jacket
Scouts can be exposed to prolonged wet weather.
Wet weather isn't always cold weather - especially when Scouts are active.

NOTE: an insulated jacket that is water repellant is NOT a waterproof jacket.

- ☐ Waterproof trousers
Dedicated waterproof trousers that go over normal trousers.

Equipment

- ☐ Hand torch
- ☐ Head torch
- ☐ Pocket money
- ☐ Spare batteries for torch
- ☐ Watch

Overnight

- ☐ Bin bag
For wet clothes etc.
- ☐ Book
- ☐ Sleeping bag
- ☐ Sleeping mat
A foam or self-inflating mat - not an airbed.
- ☐ Wash kit

Personal

- ☐ Cards / Uno
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Hand sanitiser
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Medicines
Named and labeled with dosage instructions. See leaders at the start.
- ☐ Sun cream
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ sweets
- ☐ Towel
